Ragdoll Profile & History

The Ragdoll was created in the sixties by a lady called Ann Baker in California. It was her goal was to develop cats with extraordinary personalities & wonderful dispositions ie a perfect house cat.



You will find them playing fetch , lounging on their backs or casually draped across their favourite dog .

The Ragdoll is a semi longhaired cat with a thick soft silky coat that flows into a luxurious neck ruff, thick feathers & a strong fluffy tail. Due to the texture of their fur they do not require the intensive grooming that most longhair breeds do, but a regular brushing is recommended. All Ragdolls have blue eyes.

Full development is not achieved until 3-4 years of age as the Ragdoll is one of the larger breeds of cat.

Ragdolls were so named because of their tendency to go limp when held.
