Flea & Worming Treatments:

We recommend Advantage or Revolution in your flea treatment & your Ragdoll has been regularly wormed with TROY kitten. Speak to your vet for a recommended worming treatment as your Ragdoll gets older

Dietary Requirements:

We recommend continuing with a premium wet and dry food in kitten formula and then change over to a premium adult formula at 9 months.

We feed our cats a small qty of raw meat to encourage good dental hygiene – this should not be their only food source as it doesn't provide a balanced diet.

Chicken wings are also a good work out for the teeth also but can be a little messy.

We do not feed fish to our Ragdolls until they are adults. When feeding fish to adults we use Fancy Feast, Dine and tuna in spring water.

We also offer our cats cooked chicken and occasional treats of yoghurt, cottage cheese and cooked ham.

Always ensure there is access to fresh water at all times.

Milk:

We have found that some cats will drink pre-packaged Cat Milk, others won't. NEVER give a cat or kitten normal milk - cats are generally lactose intolerant.

Litter Pan:

We recommend a recyclable paper product called 'Breeders Choice'. This can be purchased from most stores – it is very economical & easily disposed of in your GREEN WASTE bin as it is a biodegradable product (check with local council).

Points to Remember:

All cats adopted are to be housed indoors or in a cat play facility that is well shaded from the sun. Ragdolls are easily trained to walk on leashes & can play outside supervised.

A weekly comb through is highly recommended, especially in the cooler months as they are fuller coated. We incorporate a brush & comb into their playtime to ensure that are used to being groomed.
